We are thinking of arranging transport by coach—please sign up as soon as possible so that we can go ahead and book one.

Thank you to everyone who helped with and participated in **Prayer48**, which was well supported and much appreciated by many. On the Friday 62 people attended and over 80 on the Saturday. People commented on how much they valued having the space to come and pray and spend time with God at any time of the day. This year, again we recognised that Prayer48 is a very important event for us and well worth the effort. We will continue to pray for the prayer requests we have received.
