### The Collect

Almighty God, by the prayer and discipline of Lent may we enter into the mystery of Christ's sufferings, and by following in his Way come to share in his glory; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Today's Psalm is Psalm 22.23-end Praise the Lord, / you that / fear him: O seed of Jacob, glorify him; stand in awe of / him, O / seed of / Israel. For he has not despised nor abhorred the suffering of the poor; neither has he hidden his / face / from them; but when they / cried to / him he / heard them. From you comes my praise in the great / congre/gation; I will perform my vows in the / presence of / those that / fear you. The poor shall / eat and be / satisfied; those who seek the Lord shall praise him; their / hearts shall / live for / ever. All the ends of the earth shall remember and / turn to the / Lord, and all the families of the / nations shall / bow be/fore him. For the kingdom / is the / Lord's and he / rules over the / nations. How can those who sleep in the earth bow / down in / worship, or those who go down to the / dust / kneel be/fore him? He has saved my life for himself: my des/cendants shall / serve him; this shall be told of the Lord for / gene/rations to / come. They shall come and make known his salvation, to a people / yet un/born, declaring that / he, the / Lord, has / done it.
