Partnership for Missional church update: I’d like to invite you to a **Congregational Timeline** event on **Saturday 15 September** (5 -7pm, here in church), which is *for everyone* who is part of the worshipping congregations at St James’. It is designed to be an activity based around conversations where people reflect on past times, over the years they have been involved at St James. It is for newcomers and long-standing members together. The idea is to build up a collective memory of St James’ history from its early years to the current day.
